Attractions

Pranburi Forest Park

Pranburi Forest Park consists of mixed forest and mangrove. The park contains natural, beautiful sceneries and beaches. Pranburi River runs through the forest park which is an excellent place for hiking. There are 2 trails you can take, "the Pranburi Forest Park Beach trail" and "the Mangrove forest nature trail."

Sam Roi Yod National Park

Located 30 minutes from MODENA, this park ("Mountains of Three Hundred Peaks" in English) covers the mountainous coastal area between Pranburi and Kuiburi in one of Thailand's most scenic areas. It features some very nice mountain peaks overlooking the Gulf of Thailand, as well as some impressive coastal limestone cliffs. There are also several beaches, lagoons and marshes (including Thailand's largest marsh) in the area harboring over 300 species of birds. The park has a number of scenic trails that lead to breathtaking views of the coastline.

Phraya Nakhon Cave

Named after the ruler of the Southern peninsula of Thailand, who discovered this cave by accident 200 years ago, the cave has two large chambers with collapsed roofs. The chambers are 65m deep and 50m wide, with overhanging walls covered with plants and stalactites. Inside of the chambers is a pavilion built for a visit by King Rama V in 1896. It is said that when sunlight shines through on opening in the ceiling and lights the pavilion there is no cave more beautiful in Thailand.

Khao Kalok

Located 5 minutes from MODENA, this quiet coastal stretch has a beautiful beach, several restaurants and a cave with a hole through it. It gets its name from this which is translated to "skull mountain" in English. Take a bike for a spin down the long empty beach or simply relax in the shade of palm trees at Khao Kalok.

Hua Hin Hills Vineyard

Located 1 hour from MODENA is the 40-hectare Hua Hin Hills Vineyard, sitting 120 meters above sea level and caressed by moisture-laden sea breezes. The vineyard is covered with grape varieties such as Colombard, Chenin Blanc, Muscat, Shiraz, Brunello and Tempranillo. Hua Hin Hills holds professional wine tastings at The Sala, a designer restaurant on the ridge overlooking the vineyard's lush valley. During these tastings, wine gurus guide visitors on a journey of discovery through different tastes and fragrances.
